

## Current TAU & Israel Rankings (March 2018)

## TEL AVIV UNIVERSITY

- TAU is a Reuters "Top 100 Innovation University" (2017) at 88th place.
- TAU ranks 9th among the **top 10 schools globally for producing successful, VC-backed founders of companies**, in a survey of over 13,000 entrepreneurs worldwide (Pitchbook 2017). TAU is the only non-U.S. university to make the top 10 cut.
- TAU ranks 8th in the world for graduates that established "unicorn" companies worth \$1 billion or more (Sage 2017). TAU is the only non-U.S. university to make the top 10.
- TAU ranks **26th in the world for citation impact per faculty member** in the 2017 QS rankings. According to "US World News Report," citations per faculty are the best understood and most widely accepted measure of research strength and faculty productivity at a university.
- TAU ranks 10<sup>th</sup> outside the USA, 43<sup>rd</sup> in the world and 1<sup>st</sup> in Israel for US patents (2016 NAI & IPO).
- TAU is in 75<sup>th</sup> place in the world, and **leads Israel in both the number of research publications and the number of publications in the most prestigious journals** according to the 2017 Leiden Ranking, another objective measure of research strength and standing.
- TAU ranks 8th in winning European Research Council (ERC) grants among 172 leading European research institutions.

- Israel ranks **2nd in the world for innovation** out of 138 economies according to the 2016-17 Global Competitiveness Report issued by the World Economic Forum.
- It is the **3rd most educated** country among OECD countries.
- According to the 2016-17 Global Innovation Index, a joint publication of Cornell University, INSEAD and WIPO, Israel ranks:
  - o 1st for researchers
  - o 1st for **research talent in business enterprise**, a newly introduced indicator to reflect the linkages in the innovation ecosystem.
  - o 2nd for expenditure on R&D
  - o 3rd for quality of research institutions
  - o 4th in capacity for innovation
  - o 6th for availability of latest technologies
  - o 7th for university-industry research collaboration
